Guide to the plants and flowers of the Bishop's Garden

Assignment:

Each pair of students will be responsible for researching, writing, and creating a iBook chapter on a plant or flower that is located in the Bishop's Garden next to the National Cathedral in Washington, DC. The students' chapter will be included in a larger classroom iBook to serve as a free interactive guide to the plants and flowers in the Bishop's Garden visitors can download onto their iPad. Students may choose to include the following to enhance the experience: Video Clips, Audio Clips, 3D graphics, Interactive Quizzes, Presentations, Images, Primary Documents, Art, Music, Photo Galleries, Interactive Images, Voice Overs, etc.

Requirements:

- Chapter created using the Classic Theme in iBook Author
- Minimum 3 written paragraphs about the topic
- Minimum 4 different pictures of the topic
- Minimum 1 movie clip
- A bibliography (with at least three entries)

Grading:

The iBook chapter will be graded on five separate areas: Knowledge/Understanding, Communication, Application, Mechanics, and Components. A detailed rubric is attached. Each student of the pair will receive the same grade for their project.
